Visit to Heritage house at Chandor

(CHANDOR , LOUTOLIM , BENAULIM)

Pick up from the pick up point 8.00 am
9.30am - 10.30am

Fernandes house in Chandor village is one of the oldest remaining Palacios in Goa. The house has a decided air of elegance. The original house, which exhibits a Hindu Influence, was built some 500 years ago. The Portuguese influence is noticeable in the portion of the house constructed in 1821 by the Fernandes family. There is a salon in the first floor of the building that is used for receiving guests. What distinguish this house from others are its occupants to escape in case of an attack.

Visit to Benaulim Museum along with lunch

12.30 pm 2 pm

The museum is a reflection of civilizations, whether or not technically advanced. In planning the museum importance is given to the concept that the Implements represent the lifestyle of a people, their indigenous methods, their craftsmanship, their art and folklore. The original 200 privately collected items have grown to more than 4000 objects on display. The Museum nevertheless preserves its universality in its collections of artifacts representing the culture of ancient Goa.

Visit to Heritage house at Loutolim

Visit to a 400 Year old house wherein The furniture, antique showpieces, porcelain, chandeliers made out of Belgian crystal and other motifs & curios have been conserved over several generations. There is a good chance that you will feel like you have entered a different era as you set your foot into the house.
